4-H Individual Study	<p>Planned learning that occurs independently of a formal group setting; self-directed, under the supervision of adults in any 4-H subject matter/project area.</p> <p>Examples include self study, home study, and project book work. The primary purpose of 4-H Individual Study is to involve youth in a new and non-traditional 4-H environment tailored to meet their specific personal needs.</p> <p>4-H Independent Members Must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete annual 4-H Enrollment in 4HOnline. • Enroll in at least one 4-H project area for independent study. • Complete and submit the 4HYD-2163 Independent Membership Guidelines and Agreement Form annually. • Submit to the county Extension Office an educational plan/calendar including at least three goals for the year and educational resources to be used. • Complete one or more community service projects/activities during the year. • Publicly demonstrate their learning by giving a presentation before a group and/or participating in a county 4-H event or competition. • Abide by all county, state, and national 4-H policies. <p>Samples: CCS project Books, 4HI Online Lessons, Apprenticing, Software/Gaming Design</p> <p>For further assistance, contact Nancy Alexander, alexana@aces.edu</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Planned learning independent of a 4-H club or group. • Self-directed planned learning experiences under the supervision of a parent or screened 4-H volunteer. • Provides opportunity for youth to be in 4-H when a club or group is not available, or for youth who better function and learn alone. • Introduce youth to 4-H and get them involved in project work, service, and local events.
