

For 2010 Summer Camp reservations begin with the following process: if 4-H Members from your county attended our Summer Camp in 2009, your 2010 dates and numbers are already set! Basically, you have that same session, and number of spaces reserved that you *attended* with this past summer. For example: this past summer (2009), Monroe County attended Session 3 and occupied a total of 51 beds. So for 2010 Summer Camp, Monroe County is again scheduled for Session 3 with a total of 51 spaces reserved. It's that simple!

Regarding other deadlines and reservation processes, please see below:

**September 11th** – If your county or counties are on the current reservation list and you need changes to either your numbers or dates, this is the deadline to request those changes.

**September 14th - October 2nd** - If you are a county that did not attend 2009 Summer Camp, this is the allotted time to request your 2010 Summer Camp reservations. Please contact me by e-mail or phone to request your session and spaces.

**December 1st** - All deposits are due. If you have any space reserved, we must have a \$25 non-refundable deposit for each of those spaces. The deposits must be *received on site*, here at the 4-H Center, by December 1st. Any spaces we do not have a deposit for by December 1st will be opened up to anyone that wants them, on a first-come, first-served basis.

**December 2nd** - Open Enrollment begins. Any spaces we have not received a deposit for, will be open to any county, member, or non-member that requests them on a first-come, first-served basis. *However*, requests do not become reservations until confirmed by me *and* upon receipt of deposit.

**April 1st** - Final Payments due. Again, payments must be received on site at the 4-H Center by this date. Any spaces that we have not received full payment for by April 1st will be offered up to Open Enrollment.

PLEASE NOTE: The Alabama 4-H Center is changing Health and Release forms. I will send out a PDF file of the new Health and Release form, and also have it posted to the Alabama 4-H Center Summer Camp web page by September 11. *ONLY* the new Health and Release form will be accepted for the Alabama 4-H Center Summer Camp. Any pre-existing health and/or release forms *will not* be accepted for Alabama 4-H Summer Camp. Also, completed Health and Release forms for each Summer Camper must be received at the Alabama 4-H Center no later than April 1st. Additional information and instructions will accompany the September 11 PDF file.

Also, on September 14, I will send out a PDF file of the 2010 Summer Camp Brochure, as well as have it posted to the Summer Camp web page. Please feel free to download and use it as you wish. You can never promote Alabama 4-H Summer Camp too much!

Currently, there is a Summer Camp Video (from 2008) that is available on the web page. I will try to have a similar updated product available no later than October 31st. If so, the updated version will be posted on the web site, and a hard copy will also be distributed. In the meantime, if you would like a hard copy of the current video, please let me know and I will get you a copy. The current video does a fine job of presenting the Alabama 4-H Center Summer Camp message, so don't hesitate to continue using it!
