## **St. Clair County Health Fair** **Scheduled for November**

The St. Clair County Extension Resource Health Council has scheduled their annual health fair for Thursday, November 8<sup>th</sup> from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. at the Pell City Civic Center. The Council is currently seeking participants for this year's fair. There are four ways that you and your company/organization may participate.

- 1) **Corporate Sponsorship**—provides a monetary donation to cover expenses of the Health fair, including advertisement. The sponsors will be promoted during the Health Fair in various advertisements, flyers and public relation articles. The levels of sponsorship are GOLD-\$100 and SILVER-\$50.
- 2) **Vendor Booth**—subject to review and approval by the Health Resource Council based on space needs, type of service and space available. Each vendor is required to provide a \$25.00 door prize in lieu of a registration fee.
- 3) **Entertainment**—must be approved by the Health Resource Health Council for content and length of the act. Act times will be assigned, taking into consideration the convenience of the participant and will be on a “first come, first serve” basis.
- 4) **Behind the Scenes Volunteer**—will be assigned to an area of the fair that the individual is comfortable in working and at a time that is convenient for the individual. One example is working the registration area.

Please consider all four methods of participation and say “YES” to at least one level. We encourage participation on more than one level.

The health fair is designed to increase awareness and promote healthy lifestyles throughout the community. This year's theme is “Racing to Health and Wellness.” **The deadline to register is Friday, September 28, 2007.**
