




# Weed Resistance Mapping Project Garmin Colorado Instructions July 2009





## Marking a Weed Location

**Mark Waypoint - mark and record your current location and display a name for that waypoint**

		
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Press the upper right hand button above Shortcuts to bring up the Menu page.</li> <li>2. Use the Rock-n-Roller at the top and navigate to Mark Waypoint.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>3. When you are at the location in the field you wish to mark, press the button in the middle of the Rock-n-Roller. You will see a message that your current location was saved.</li> <li>4. Use the Rock-n-Roller to highlight Edit and press the Rock-n-Roller center button.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>5. Use the Rock-n-Roller to change the name to something you will remember to associate with the weed resistance project.</li> <li>6. When finished press the upper right hand button above Done. Each location will need to have an independent name.</li> </ol>

## Sending Locations

**To locate the weed resistance locations you marked and send them in:**

			
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Press the upper right hand button above Shortcuts to bring up the Menu page.</li> <li>2. Use the Rock-n-Roller at the top and navigate to Where To? Press the center button of the Rock-n-Roller to select.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>3. Highlight Waypoints and select by pressing center button of the Rock-n-Roller.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>4. Locate and highlight the location you saved; press the center of the Rock-n-Roller to select.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>5. GPS coordinates for the saved location are displayed. Email the coordinates to Amy Winstead, <a href="mailto:winstat@auburn.edu">winstat@auburn.edu</a>  (coordinates for this example are N 34°41.356'; W 086°52.995')</li> </ol>
