

Some Good Tomatoes to Try

These varieties have done well in many taste tests and are recommended for their overall flavor.

Sun Gold - Bright orange cherry tomato described as sugary, fruity and delicious. Indeterminate 57 days.

Brandywine - Heirloom Amish variety with several variants. In a good year has rich succulent flavor. Indeterminate 80 days

Arkansas Traveler-This variety produces well in hot weather with lots of flavorful 6-8 oz. fruits. Indeterminate 85 days

Better Boy - VFN resistant hybrid with lots of fruit, perfect for tomato sandwiches. "One of the best tasting garden tomatoes available anywhere." Indeterminate 75 days

Park's Whopper - VFFNT hybrid. A good main season slicing tomato with good flavor. Indeterminate 65 days.

Rutgers - VFA Classic canning tomato with terrific flavor. Determinate 75 days

Cherokee Purple - Heirloom from Tennessee with pleasantly sweet rich flavor. Indeterminate 80 days.

Momotaro - The most popular tomato in Japan, " rich and sweet with just the right amount of acid". Indeterminate 74 days

Principe Borghese - favorite Italian variety for drying. Determinate 75 days.

San Marzano - Popular variety for canning, paste or puree. Has a mild flavor and meaty texture. Indeterminate 80 days.

Roma VF - Classic paste tomato. Determinate 78 days.
