



## Fall Fest 2007 Canning Rules

- Entries will be in glass, standard one-pint or one-quart canning jars. Half-gallon jars, mayonnaise jars or any other type jar will not be accepted.
- All jars must be sealed using flat canning lids and have rings left on.
- All entries must have been produced, prepared, and processed by the exhibitor in the past year. Youth and adult entries will be accepted.
- Entries will be accepted from 10-11am on Saturday, October 13<sup>th</sup> at the Canning tent of the Fall Festival, Buckner Circle, McClellan.
- Judging will take place from 11-12noon.

### **Score for judging home canning:**

1. Quality of Product (appearance, natural color, etc.....).....45
  2. Quality of Pack (good proportion of product to juice)... ..15
  3. Quality of liquid (clear and free of sediment).....30
  4. Appearance of jar (clean standard jar, new lids and bands) ..10
- Total.....100
