ART

ART DIVISION I AND IA

- All art work must be entered and in the exhibit building according to the rules of the fair.
- All exhibits must be the original work of the exhibitor. No copies will be accepted that are recognized as work of another artist.
- All art work must have been painted within the last 3 years and not previously entered in the fair.
- All paintings must be suitably framed or matted.
- All entries must remain during the week of the fair.
- The Fair Committee shall have the right to limit the number of entries per exhibitor.
- Those engaged in any line of work in the art business as a professional or as a teacher of same, are considered professionals and must exhibit in the professional class. An amateur is one who paints for a hobby and whose income from art is less than \$300 per year. Professional artwork will be judged separately.

LIVESTOCK/SPECIAL RULES

- All animals are entered at the owner's risk. The Fair Committee will assume no obligation for injuries or losses resulting to any livestock or exhibition.
- Care, feed and water will be the responsibility of each exhibitor.
- Each exhibitor is responsible for keeping his penning area clean.

LAMB SHOW

- Lamb Show is open to 4-H or FFA members ages 9-18 as of 12/31/2010 in Chilton & adjoining counties.
- Entries must be either wether or ewe lambs.
- All entries must have their milk teeth. Lambs should be born after Jan. 1, 2010
- Lambs must have tails docked and should be shown in short fleece.
- Lambs must be in barn by 5:00 p.m. Tuesday, Sept. 28. Show will begin at 6:00 p.m. Lambs will be divided into weight classes. There will be Beginner, JR & SR Showmanship classes.
- Premiums: 1st - \$10, 2nd - \$7.50, 3rd - \$5, Grand Champion - \$20, Reserve Grand Champion - \$15, Champion - \$15, Reserve Champion - \$10. Beginner, Jr. and Sr. Show-man-ship: 1st - \$10, 2nd - \$7.50, 3rd - \$5.

MARKET MEAT GOAT SHOW

- Open to 4-H or FFA members ages 9-18 as of 12/31/2010, in Chilton & adjoining counties
- Entries must be either wether or does.
- All entries must have their milk teeth.
- Goats must be born after January 1, 2010.
- Goats must be in the barn by 5:00 p.m., Tues., Sept. 28. Show will begin immediately after the lamb show. Goats will be divided into weight classes. There will be beginner, junior and senior showmanship.
- Premiums: 1st - \$10, 2nd - \$7.50, 3rd - \$5, Champion \$15, Reserve Champion \$10, Beginner, Jr. and Sr. Showmanship: 1st \$10, 2nd \$7.50, 3rd - \$5.

STEER DIVISION

- Exhibitors must be legal residents of Chilton Co. or own farms in Chilton County and members of 4-H or FFA, ages 9-18 as of 12/31, 2010.
- Steers should be weighed and in place at barn by 5:00 p.m., Thursday, Sept. 30. Show will begin at 6:00 p.m. Steers will be released following the show.
- Steers will be divided into six weight classes. There will be Beginner, Junior and Senior Showmanship classes.
- Premiums: 1st - \$25, 2nd - \$22, 3rd - \$20, 4th - \$18, 5th - \$15. Champion - \$15, Reserve Champion - \$10, Grand Champion - \$20, Reserve Grand Champion - \$15. Beginner, Junior and Senior Showmanship: 1st - \$10, 2nd - \$7.50, 3rd - \$6, 4th - \$5, 5th - \$4.

BEEF SHOW

- Beef show is open to 4-H or FFA members in Alabama, ages 9-18 as of 12/31/2010.
- Animals for exhibition in Purebred Beef Show must be placed in the barn by 12:00 noon on Sat., Oct. 2nd. Show will begin at 3:00 p.m. Cattle will be released from fairgrounds after the Show.

- Registration papers will be proof of age. Tattoo will be read at check-in (12:00 noon)
- Breed Show will be provided for any breed entry with registration papers. Any animals without registration papers will be shown in Commercial Division.

HEIFER DIVISION

- Classes will be provided for heifers born Sept. 1, 2008 through March 31, 2010. Classes will be broken according to age, with a maximum of six classes per breed. There will be Beginner, Junior and Senior Showmanship classes.
- Premiums: 1st - \$25, 2nd - \$22, 3rd - \$20, 4th - \$18, 5th thru 10th - \$15. Breed Champion \$15, Reserve Breed Champion - \$10, Beginner, Junior and Senior Showmanship: 1st - \$10, 2nd - \$7.50, 3rd - \$6, 4th - \$5, 5th - \$4

BULL DIVISION

- Classes will be provided for Bulls calved Sept. 1, 2008 through March 31, 2010. Classes will be broken according to age, with a maximum of six classes per breed
- Premiums: 1st - \$25, 2nd - \$22, 3rd - \$20, 4th - \$18, 5th thru 10th - \$15. Breed Champion - \$15, Reserve Breed Champion - \$10.
