### **Seminar for Vegetable Growers**

On March 6, 2008 a special vegetable seminar will take place at the Cane Creek Community Garden and Education Center, located at the former Ft. McClellan in Calhoun County. The primary focus of the program will be to demonstrate the use of plasticulture for the production of vegetables. There is a \$3.00 registration fee per person, due by February 29th. Lunch will be provided. Checks should be made payable to the Calhoun County Extension Office and mailed it to the Calhoun County Extension Office, 1702 Noble Street, Suite 108. Anniston, AL 36201. The program will run from 9:00 till 3:00 p.m. with lunch provided.

Directions: (Follow Highway 21 to the new Lowe's Building Center near Anniston Middle School, just north of Anniston. Turn east at the traffic light and follow New Summerall Gate Road about 2 miles, passing soccer fields on your right and baseball fields on your left. Just past the baseball fields, you will see Long Leaf Lodge on the right. Turn right onto Justice Avenue and the garden is on your immediate left, # 77. (map on reverse) Look for the **Cane Creek Community Garden Education Center**.
