LAWN CARE WORKSHOP TO BE HELD AT AUBURN

The Alabama Cooperative Extension System will conduct a Regional Home Lawn Care Workshop in Auburn, Alabama, on Saturday, April 14, 2007. The workshop is intended for home owners and lawn care providers. Extension Agents and Specialists will be on hand to discuss lawn nutrition, lawn maintenance, and how to handle lawn pests, such as plant diseases, insects, and weeds. The workshop will be held on the campus of Auburn University. The morning lecture and exhibit portion of the workshop will be held at the AU Ham Wilson Arena on Donahue Drive from 8:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. After lunch, the workshop will continue with various demonstrations at the AU Turf Research Unit along Shug Jordan Pkwy and South College.

In addition to the educational lectures, a few home lawn care businesses will be on hand to discuss and exhibit their products and services. Homeowners will have the chance to learn more about the many new lawn care products they can use to maintain and improve their own home lawns.

The workshop is scheduled for Saturday, April 14th on the Auburn University Campus. It will begin at 8:30 a.m. and will conclude by 2:30 p.m. that day.
