Opportunity to Learn About Invasive Plants

Would you like to learn more about invasive plants? Ever wonder what all the fuss is about concerning Cogongrass? The Alabama Invasive Plant Council will hold its' Sixth Annual Conference on May 13, 2008 from 8:00 AM to 4:45 PM at the Alabama 4-H Center. In addition, if you are a consulting forester, or a certified pesticide applicator, a certified arborist, or a logger with a PLM number, this training will count towards continuing education credits. The registration fee is \$35.

Conference participants will be eligible for the awarding of 10 recertification points for pesticide applicators as well as 5 CFE credits for foresters. ISA has approved the meeting for 4.5 CEU's for Certified Arborists. Further, Municipal Specialist and Board Certified Master Arborist points have been approved too. AFA has approved the meeting for 6 hours of PLM credit.
