On Thursday, October 18th there will be a food entrepreneur workshop in Autauga County. This workshop is designed to provide entrepreneurs with an understanding of the key issues they will need to consider when starting a food business. The topics discussed will include labeling, processing and co-packing, health department inspection, etc.

Who should attend this meeting: Participants include individuals interested in marketing a family recipe, individuals with a product idea or concept, producers considering adding value to an agricultural product, restaurateurs exploring the manufacturing of a house specialty, and storeowners contemplating the development of a private label product.
