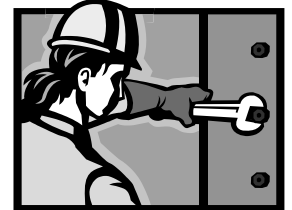

### The Rules!

- Your art must be made from Lego's<sup>®</sup> or other toy blocks.\*\*
- Do not build a design from a kit. You can use pieces from a kit, but you must create your own Lego<sup>®</sup> or toy design.
- Your project can't be any larger than 12 inches wide x 15 inches wide x 16 inches tall.
- Carry it on a firm, flat surface like foam board or plywood. Think about ways to keep it from coming apart.
- Your name, school and grade must be on a piece of paper that is lightly taped to your art.
- You must do all the work yourself.
