## Poster Contest Guidelines

1. Use ½ sheet of white poster board turned **horizontal**, like this . Your poster will be 14" tall and 22" wide.
2. Design and draw a poster with artwork related to the theme. **Put the theme on the poster!**  
**Theme description:** Explore the relationship between farm and city with a special focus on the way farmers care for their animals and our food. Learn more about the steps farmers take to make sure they raise healthy animals and produce safe food for our families.
3. Do not use computer graphics. Do not glue anything to your poster. You can use pen, pencil, crayon, watercolor, ink, and oil for your artwork.
4. Put your name, address, school, grade, birthday and phone number on the back of the poster.
5. Turn in your poster to your 4-H Teacher or to the 4-H Office no later than **Friday, November 13<sup>th</sup>**.

## Awards

***Based on Relating to the theme, Creativity, Originality, and Neatness!***

1. Every poster receives a participation ribbon.
2. **First, Second, and Third place awards** in each division in Lauderdale county sponsored by the **Lauderdale County Farmers Federation Women's Committee.**
3. **1st place state award: \$200 cash & \$200 cash to student's classroom**  
**2nd place state award: \$100 cash & \$100 cash to student's classroom**
4. The top 12-14 designs in the state will be put into a calendar that will be distributed throughout the state.
