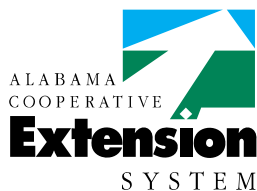

#### Directions

##### *From Birmingham:*

Take I-65 N to Exit 310 Cullman/Moulton. Turn left onto HWY 157N. Travel approx. 57 miles to HWY 20/ US 72-ALT West and travel approximately 22 miles to Cherokee. Turn North on Main St. (there is a Chevron gas station at this intersection), travel to second intersection and turn right (east). At next intersection (approx. 1 block), turn left (North) onto North Pike. Travel North for approximately 3 miles, to grain bins, which will be on your right with 'Isbell Farms' sign in front.

##### *From Nashville:*

From I-65 South, take Exit 340A towards Decatur. Turn right onto Wilson Street (red light after you cross the Tennessee River). This road is also HWY 20/US 72-ALT. Travel approximately 60 miles to Cherokee, AL. Turn North on Main St. (there is a Chevron gas station at this intersection), travel to second intersection and turn right (east). At next intersection (approx. 1 block), turn left (North) onto North Pike. Travel North for approximately 3 miles, to grain bins, which will be on your right with 'Isbell Farms' sign in front.

##### *From Iuka, MS:*

HWY 72 East to Cherokee. There is a Piggly Wiggly grocery store on the north side of the road as you enter Cherokee. Turn North on Main St. (there is a Chevron gas station at this intersection), travel to second intersection and turn right (east). At next intersection (approx. 1 block), turn left (North) onto North Pike. Travel North for approximately 3 miles, to grain bins, which will be on your right with 'Isbell Farms' sign in front.
