Categories

- **Cookies:** All cookies* including brownies* and squares*
- **Cakes:** All cakes including cupcakes*
- **Breads:** All biscuits*, muffins*, cornbread, loaves, and yeast breads

** Bring one dozen of smaller baked food items*

Rules

- Each person may enter only one category (cookies, cakes, or breads)
- Each person may enter only one product (example: cupcakes)
- **NO MIXES ARE ALLOWED!**
- **No Candy or Pies will be judged (Fudge is a candy.)**
- **Products are to be made by the 4-H member, but the 4-Her may have help**
- **Provide a copy of the recipe including the title. It may be on an index card or sheet of paper typed or hand written.**
- **Your name must be on the recipe and/or on the dish!**

Judging

- **1st, 2nd or 3rd Place will be selected in each category per club.**
- **Only 1st Place in each category will be invited to participate in the county-wide program held at Madison County 4-H Round- Up.**
- **Cookies, cakes, or breads are due the date your local leader gives you.**

Taste.....25 points

Texture.....10 points

Appearance15 points
