RULES and REGULATIONS:

- The theme for this year's contest is: **Fuel Up with Milk**
- Each contestant will make a poster 14"X22" about milk, milk products and/or milk production. The poster should center on this year's theme.
- Use material from dairy plants, milk cooperatives, dairy magazines, or any other appropriate source.
- Do NOT use popular cartoon characters or other symbols under copyright protection.
- The contestant's name, club/school, and county must be on the back of each poster.
- Each contestant must bring their completed poster to the designated club meeting in order to receive recognition.

JUDGING:

- The county 4-H Agent Assistant will arrange for all county entries to be judged and for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place county posters to be selected.
- Judges will judge and score posters on a total of 100 points:

AWARDS: Recognition, county contest ribbons, and state prizes are courtesy of the American Dairy Association (ADA) of Alabama.

- The 1st, 2nd and 3rd place county posters in each age division will be awarded a 4-H rosette ribbon.
- The 1st place poster in each age division will be mailed to and entered automatically in the State Contest.
- Three State winners for the two age divisions will be honored. State Level Contest Winners receive:
1st: Rosette and \$75 2nd: Rosette and \$50 3rd: Rosette and \$25.
