(All adult volunteers, parents, and youth who plan to attend Camp: Please read this document carefully. If you have questions about some of the things we ask you to do or not to do, PLEASE ASK. After you have read this Code of Conduct and feel that you understand what we are asking you to do and not to do, please sign on the line at the bottom of the page. If you cannot or will not abide by this Code of Conduct, you will be sent home. The Code of Conduct that you sign will be strictly enforced.)

**I understand that:**

1. The use of tobacco, alcohol, or other controlled substances and profane language are strictly forbidden.
2. Curfew (10:00) will be adhered to strictly.
3. You are expected to treat other participants with the same respect you want for yourself.
4. Destruction or theft of personal, 4-H Center, DCNR, 4-H or any other property is unacceptable.
5. Public displays of affection are unacceptable behavior.
6. Individuals rooming together should decide on their own "house rules". Please respect each other's privacy.
7. No one will be allowed to leave the group activities for any reason other than illness.
8. No one is allowed to leave the grounds of the facility at any time, unless it is with an authorized adult. Authorized adults will be determined by the person in charge of the County group.
9. Participants will be considerate of other 4-H'ers, volunteers, agents, and other guests. Quiet Time will be observed from 10:00 PM until 7:00 AM.
10. "Horseplay" or pranks will not be tolerated.
11. No one is allowed to leave his or her room after curfew.
12. At no time will males be allowed to visit females' rooms or will females be allowed to visit males' rooms.
13. Disrespect for group facilitators and instructors will not be tolerated.
14. Any Extension staff member, 4-H Center staff member, or Adult Leader at the event has the right to reprimand any participant.
