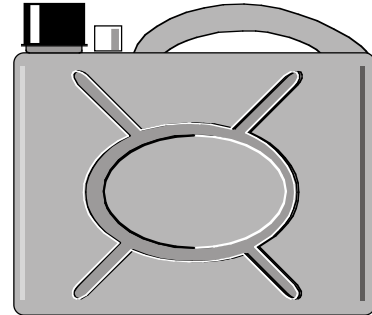
Gasoline Hauling and Storage Tips

WARNING!

- DO NOT smoke around gasoline.
- DO NOT leave your engine running while filling containers.

CONTAINERS must be...

- Grounded metal or durable plastic
- Red
- Lab-approved



DO NOT USE GLASS CONTAINERS OR FOOD CONTAINERS!

FILLING CONTAINERS

- Avoid static electricity to avoid fire...
 - Place can on the ground to fill. **DO NOT LEAVE IT IN THE VEHICLE TO FILL!**
 - Gas nozzle should always be touching the container until finished filling.
 - Fill the container **SLOWLY**.
- Don't fill completely...leave space for heat expansion.
- **DO NOT LOCK THE NOZZLE** for filling.

TRANSPORTING

- Check gas caps and vent caps for tightness.
- Wipe off spilled gas before putting cans in your vehicle.
- Make sure the cans will not tip over.
- Position cans to avoid exposure to direct sunlight.
- Cover with a tarp if possible.
- **NEVER** transport gas in the passenger compartment of a vehicle.

STORAGE

- Store gas in a well-ventilated shed, if possible, away from the house and equipment.
- Use only approved containers for storage.
- Limit **indoor** storage to 10 gallons.
- Keep away from children.
