- There are three divisions: K-3rd grade, 4th-6th grade, & 7th-12th grade
- Only one scarecrow entry per classroom or group
- Scarecrows can be constructed of any non-hazardous material: straw, metal, cloth, etc. **Please DO NOT INCLUDE any valuable objects in your display.**
- No scarecrow may depict a real person. All scarecrows must be in good taste or will be removed. **No bloody or gory entries please!**
- Please make a laminated sign with your class and school name to be placed in your scarecrow display
- Entry forms must be returned to the St. Clair Extension Office by October, 17 2008 at 4:30 p.m.
- Scarecrows must be set-up on the Ashville Courthouse lawn by Monday, October 27th at 8:00 a.m. to be judged
- Scarecrows must be removed no later than November 2, 2007 (We would like scarecrows to remain up through Halloween.)

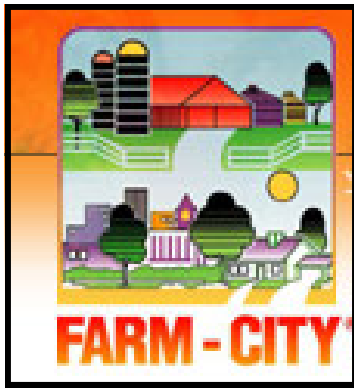
Cash Prizes for each category:
