Upcoming 4-H Happenings

Online registration is now available for 4-H summer camp for youth ages 9-14. There are 3-day camp sessions available from May 31st—June 16th. The cost of the camp is \$85 that includes lodging and meals. Campers will rotate through three general program areas that include archery, waterfront, canoeing, pool and a climbing wall.
