



School's Out, Let Summer Vacation Begin!! **Sign Your Kids Up Now for Extension's Funshops!**

Well it's official, school is out and summer vacation has begun! It won't be long before you hear you kids say, "Mom, I'm bored!" So what is there to do during the summer? St. Clair County Extension and 4-H are providing something fun yet educational for your kids to do this summer.

We are now taking registration for our 2nd Annual 4-H Clover Classroom. Just what is 4-H Clover Classroom? It is a series of youth workshops for kids age 9-14 held in the month of July and you don't have to be a member of 4-H to participate. This year we will be offering the following "funshops":

- Beginner Kids Cooking Camp- Come cook with us! Learn basic cooking skills along with food/kitchen safety & cake decorating.
- Fit to Ride ATV Safety- Basic ATV safety for all levels of rider. There will not be ATV riding during this class.
- Advanced Cooking Camp – Students must have attended the beginner class this year or last year. Students will learn bread making, basic canning and more advanced cooking skills.
- GPS, Orienteering and Geocaching – Go on a scavenger hunt using Global Positioning Systems to find your clues! Learn basic GPS skills and plant a Geocache! Learn to use a compass to find your way!
- 4-H Rocketry – Learn the basics of rocket construction, make your own rocket and launch it that day!
- 4-H Sportfishing – Learn basic fishing skills, tackle crafting and even try your hand at catching a few. Bring your fishing pole if you have one!

All workshops have size limits and a small fee to cover lunch. Registration forms are available at the Extension Office located in the St. Clair County Courthouse in Pell City
