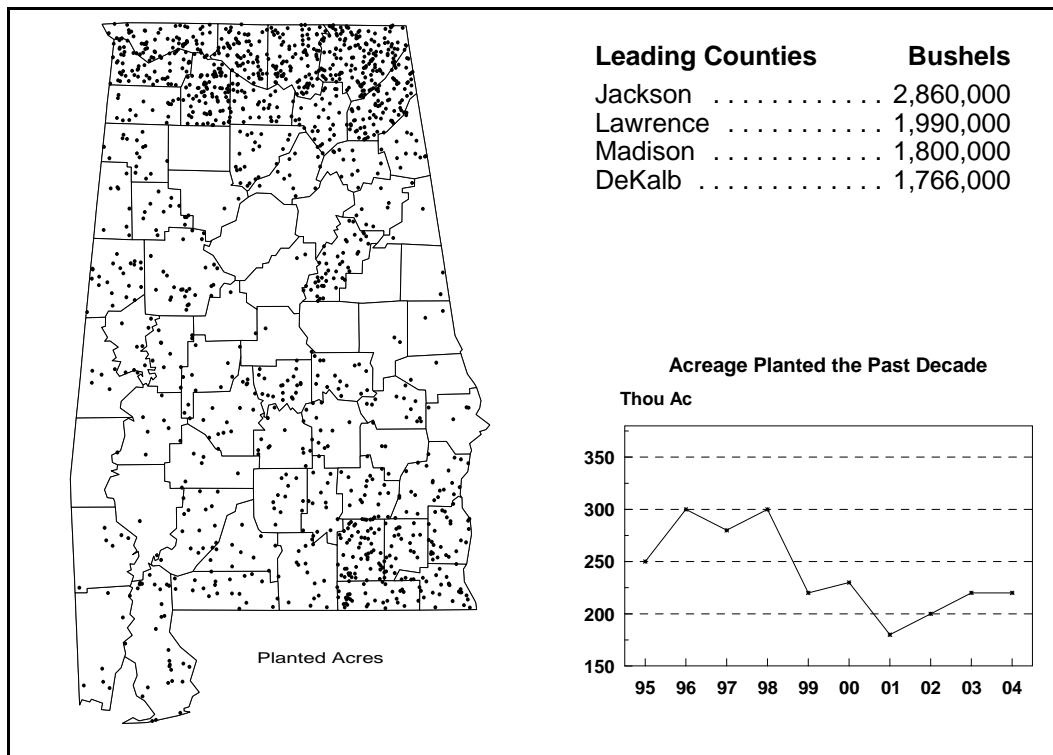

Corn Acreage And Production, 2004



Jackson county topped all other Alabama counties in corn production for 2004 with 2,860,000 bushels. The 22,000 acres harvested by the county's producers averaged 130 bushels per acre. This was 7 bushels above the state average.

Other top producing counties for the year were: Lawrence, Madison, and DeKalb.

Alabama corn producers harvested a total of 195,000 acres in 2004. Yield per acre was 123 bushels. Production totaled 23.9 million bushels and was valued at \$57.5 million.

Alabama ranked 29th in the United States in corn grain production. Iowa, Illinois, Nebraska, Minnesota, and Indiana were the leading states.
