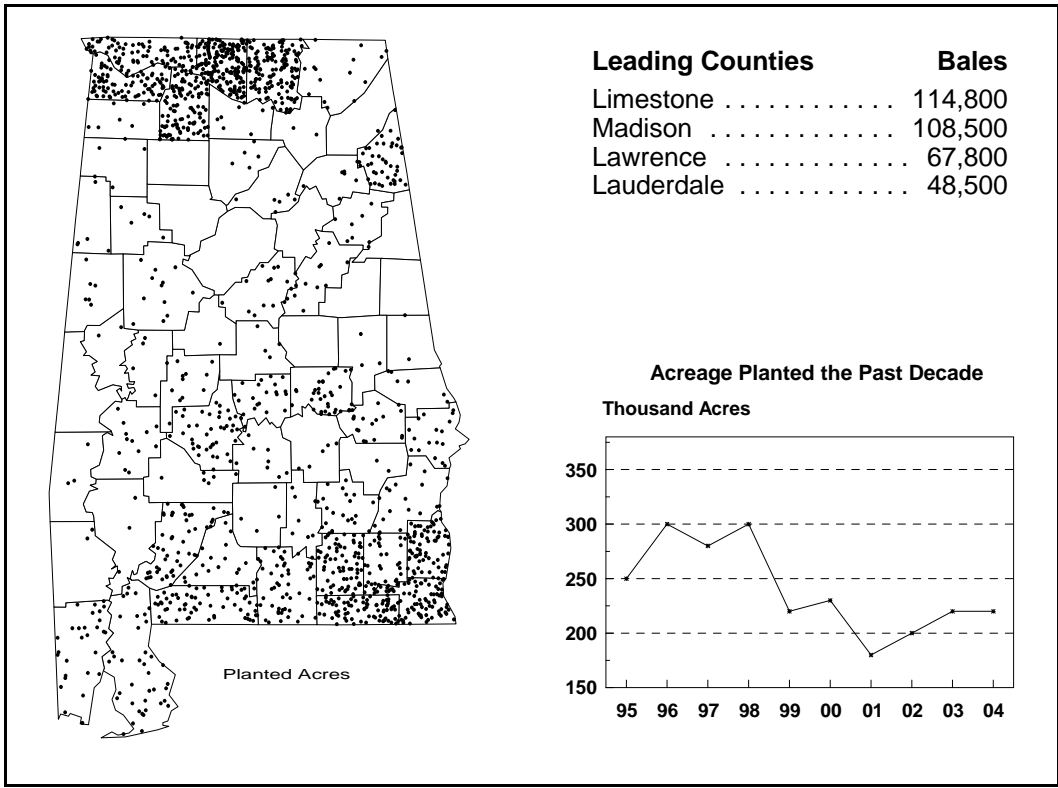

Cotton Acreage And Production, 2004



Limestone County topped all other Alabama counties in cotton production for 2004 with 114,800 bales. The 64,300 acres harvested by the county's producers averaged 857 pounds per acre. This was 133 pounds above the state average. Other top producing counties for the year were: Madison, Lawrence, and Lauderdale.

Alabama cotton producers harvested a total of 540,000 acres in 2004, up 30,000 acres from the previous year. Yield per acre was 724 pounds of lint. Production totaled 814,000 bales and was valued at \$205.0 million.

Alabama ranked 8th in the United States in cotton production. Texas, Mississippi, Arkansas, California, and Georgia were five leading states.
