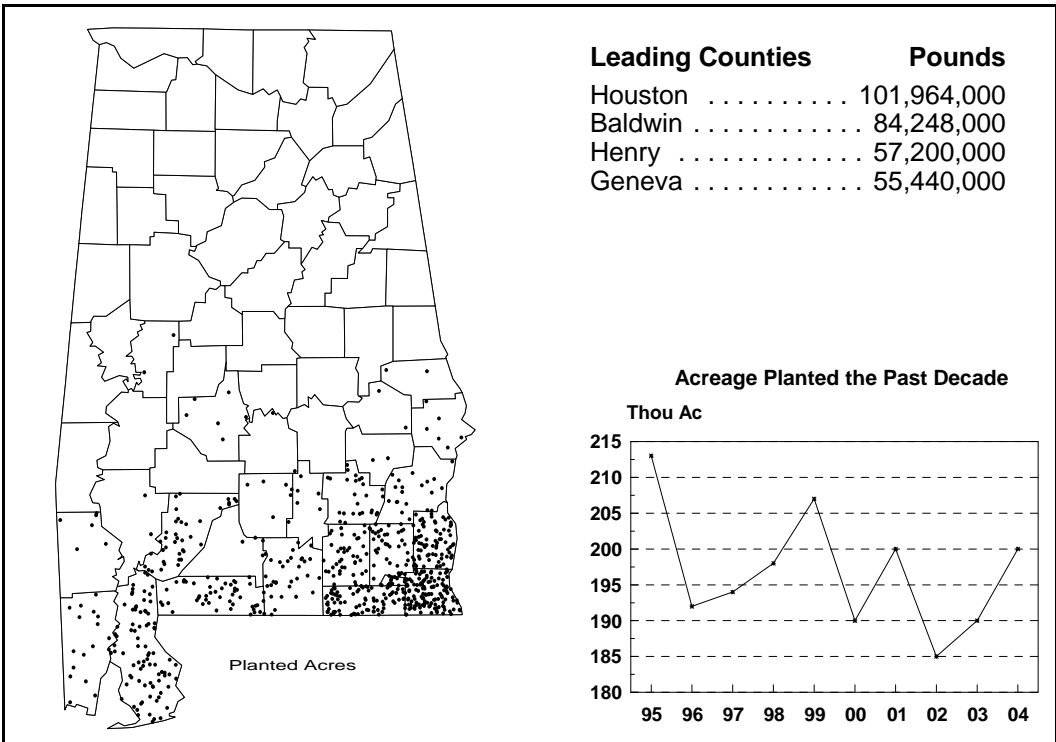

Peanut Acreage And Production, 2004



Houston County topped all other Alabama counties in peanut production for 2004 with 101,964,000 pounds. The 40,300 acres harvested by the county's producers averaged 2,530 pounds per acre, which was 270 pounds below the state average.

Other top producing counties for the year were: Houston, Baldwin, Henry, and Geneva.

Alabama peanut producers harvested a total of 199,000 acres in 2004, an increase of 14,000 acres above previous year. Yield per acre was 2,800 pounds. Production totaled 557.2 million pounds and was valued at \$105.3 million.

Alabama ranked 3rd in the United States in peanut production. Georgia and Texas were the leading states.
