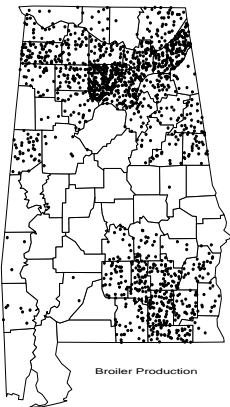
## Broiler Production, 2004

During the 2004 marketing year, Alabama broiler growers produced 1.052 billion, up 1 percent from previous marketing year. Alabama ranked third in production behind Arkansas and Georgia. Cullman county was the leading producer, followed by DeKalb, Marshall and Blount counties. Cash receipts amounted to \$2.41 billion, up 31 percent from 2003.

## Egg Production, 2004

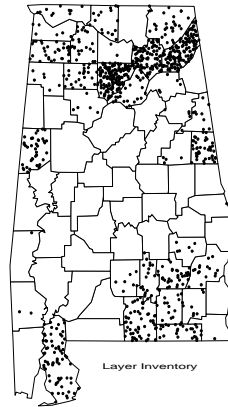
Egg production was 2.10 billion, down 4 percent from 2003. Cash receipts totaled \$288.0 million, down 2 percent from previous year. Nationally, Alabama ranked 13th in egg production. There were 9.24 million layers 20 weeks old and older on hand December 1, 2004, compared with 9.33 million a year earlier. Cullman county had the largest inventory, followed by DeKalb, Marshall, Baldwin, Covington and Randolph counties.
