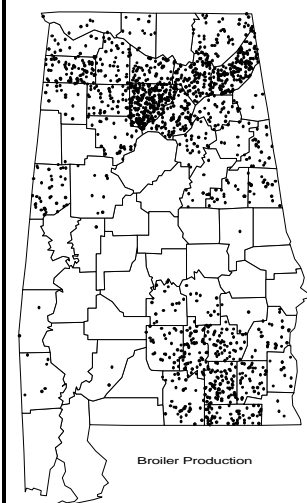
Broiler Production, 2001

During the 2001 marketing year, Alabama broiler growers produced 1.0 billion birds, down 3 percent from previous marketing year. Alabama ranked third in production behind Georgia and Arkansas. Cullman county was the leading producer, followed by DeKalb, Marshall, Blount, and Coffee counties. Cash receipts amounted to \$2.0 billion, up 15 percent from 2000.

Egg Production, 2001

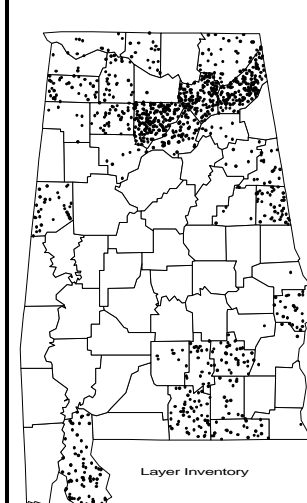
Egg production was 2.36 billion, down 1 percent from 2000. Cash receipts totaled \$265.4 million, up 3 percent from previous year. Nationally, Alabama ranked 13th in egg production. There were 10.4 million layers 20 weeks old and older on hand December 1, 2001 compared with 10.2 million a year earlier. Cullman county had the largest inventory, followed by DeKalb, Marshall, Baldwin, and Blount counties.
