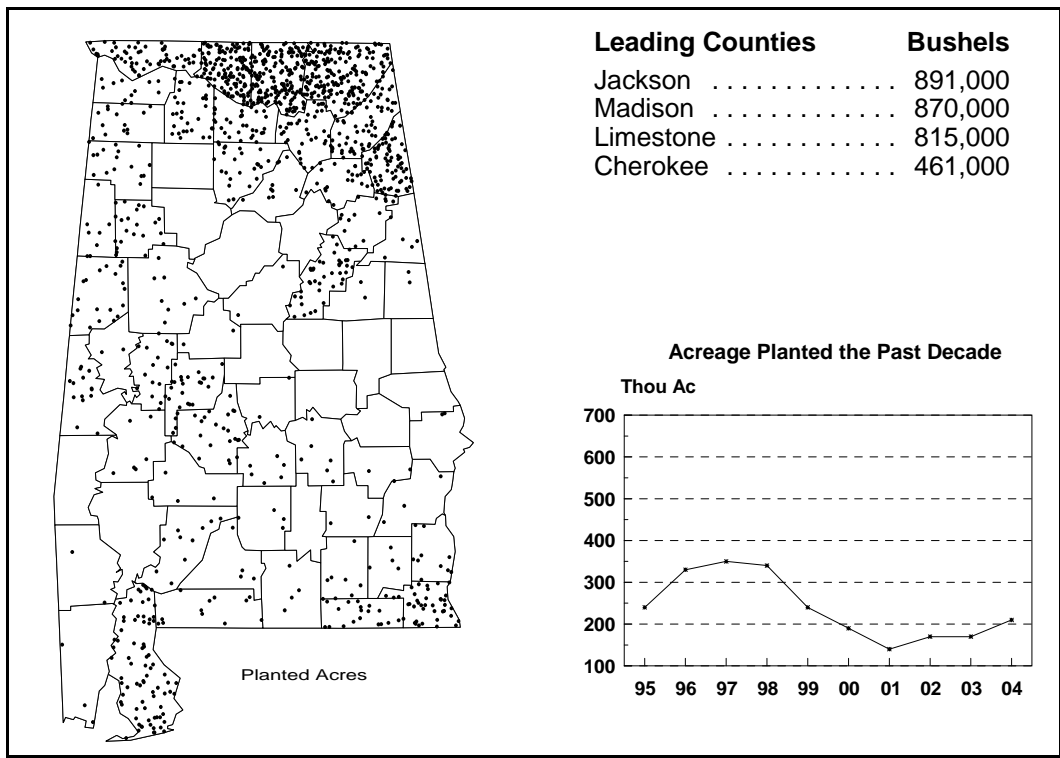

## Soybeans Acreage And Production, 2004



Jackson County topped all other Alabama counties in soybean production for 2004 with 891,000 bushels. The 26,000 acres harvested by the county's producers averaged 34 bushels per acre.

Other top producing counties for the year were: Madison, Limestone, and Cherokee.

Alabama soybean producers harvested a total of 190,000 acres in 2004 up 30,000 acres from the previous year. Yield per acre was 35 bushels. Production totaled 6.6 million bushels and was valued at \$36.2 million.

Alabama ranked 28th in the United States in soybean production. Illinois, Iowa, Indiana, Minnesota, and Missouri were leading states.
