Each section of this checklist is worth 20 points. The total project is worth 100 points.

1. Required information:
 - a. All information relevant to topic chosen
 - b. List positions available within chosen category
 - c. Estimated salary for at least one position within the chosen category (student must include credible reference as to where the information was found)
 - d. Amount of education required for at least one position within the category
 - e. Explanation of how the position or category relates to the overall aquaculture industry (this section should include a clear description of the category or position and how it fits into the aquaculture industry, why is this position relevant to the aquaculture industry?)

2. A reference page or bibliography should be included at the end of the presentation.
 - a. Location of information (book, article, website, etc.)
 - b. Name of author or organization
 - c. Date of publication
 - d. Date accessed

3. Presentation should be at least 5 slides with a maximum of 15 slides.
 - a. Should contain title slide
 - b. Should be at least 5 slides excluding the title slide
 - c. Last slide should be the bibliography or reference page

4. The presentation should reflect strong knowledge of the topic and credible research.

5. Overall presentation:
 - a. Presentation should be informative
 - b. Presentation should be creative to capture the attention of the other students
 - c. Student presentation should be professional
 - d. Student must exhibit clear knowledge of the topic
