



ANIMAL SAFETY

- 1. Remember that animals may be friendly, but they are extremely strong and spook much easier at night than in the daytime.**
- 2. Stay out of corners and areas from which escape is difficult when working with animals.**
- 3. Remember that friendly bulls can be very unpredictable when cows are in heat.**
- 4. Be wary of newly acquired livestock.**
- 5. Make sure all stock enclosures are in good repair.**
- 6. Close gates securely.**
- 7. Always report unusual animal behavior that could signal illness.**
- 8. Request veterinary assistance for sick livestock.**
- 9. Remove dead livestock as soon as possible.**
- 10. Handle vaccines and medicines with care.**
- 11. Work cattle with two people when possible.**
- 12. ASK if you are unsure about anything dealing with live stock.**
