



TOOL SAFETY

- 1. Use the proper serviceable tool for the job.**
- 2. Do not use cheater bars/pipes on wrenches.**
- 3. Use the proper size wrench/socket if available; adjustable wrenches are secondary tools.**
- 4. Never remove safety guards/shields from power tools.**
- 5. Do not use a power tool you are unfamiliar with or one which you have not been trained on.**
- 6. Place unservicable tools in the repair basket and inform the proprietor of your action.**
- 7. Use only serviceable ladders, and inspect them before use.**
- 8. Never lay a tool on the ground while in the field—it will be lost.**
- 9. Keep power tools out of the path of vehicles.**
- 10. Wear eye protection when grinding, sharpening, or cutting.**
- 11. ASK if unsure about the use of a tool.**
