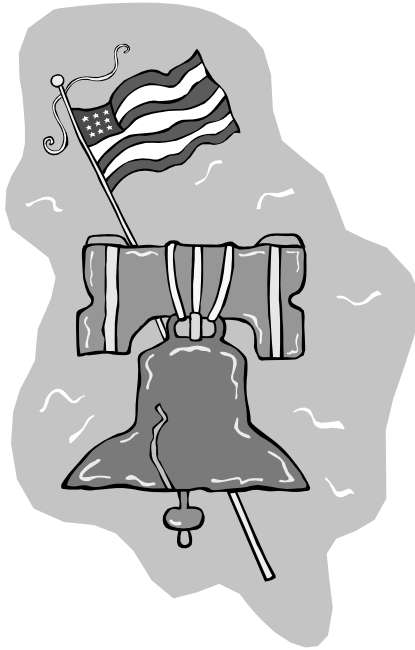




**Present It With Power:
