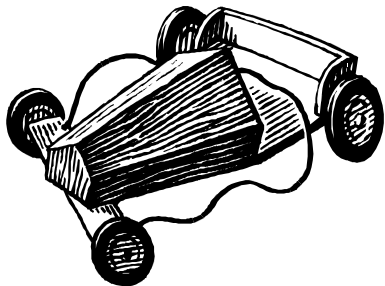




## What Wood U Build?

**What Wood U Build?** helps you learn about woodworking. You make decisions about what you like. You can design your own project or you find a plan that you would like to follow.

In 2007, Alabama 4-Hers will build wooden toys.

This project lets you:

- Show off your creativity.
- Learn about design and construction.
- Use your skill as an artist and craftsman.
- Plan, organize and carry through on a challenging project.

## The Rules

The rules are:

- It can't be any larger than 18 inches x 18 inches x 18 inches.
- You must:
  - Create an original design or
  - Work from a pattern which you have found.
- You must do all the construction yourself.
- You can't use a kit.
- Your name and county need to be on a small piece of tape attached to your project.
- Provide a copy of your plan.
