Eligibility: Participants must be bona fide members of Alabama 4-H. each county may bring a Junior and Senior team (4 per team) and all individuals who may wish to compete for individual awards. The winning Senior team will represent Alabama at the National 4-H Wildlife Habitat Evaluation Contest. A HEALTH card for each 4-H member participating in the event must be in the possession of the Coach or Agent at the event.

Divisions: Junior 4-H'ers are those between the ages of 9 & 13. Senior 4-H'ers are those who have reached their 14th birthday as of January 1, 2006 and have not yet reached their 19th birthday.

Contest Preparation: YANR-197 and YANR-186 should be used to prepare for the contest (see links). Please note that we will be doing "harvest more- harvest less" this year. However, we will not be doing oral reasons.

Fees: There will be a \$10.00 cost for all participants and coaches. One check for all of the 4-Hers and parents in the delegation should be included with the registration form.

Contest Site(s): Auburn High School is located on the corner of Dean Road and Samford Avenue. The large auditorium parking lot is on Samford Avenue. Most of the activities will be conducted at Auburn High School. Each county should make their own hotel reservations.

Awards: Awards will be given to the top three individuals and teams in each category.
