The Rules

- Your art must be made from Lego's[®] or other toy blocks.
- The project size is restricted to 18" x 18" x 18" in measurement.
- For stability it is suggested you use 12 inches x 15 inches wide and 16 inches tall.
- Your art will be placed on a table. It can be seen from all sides.
- Carry it on a firm, flat surface like foam board or plywood. Think about ways to keep it from coming apart.
- Your name should be on piece of paper that is lightly taped to your art.
- You must do all the work yourself.
