



# Natural Science Camp

## For Youth Ages 9-13

### July 9-10, 2009

**Where:** Alabama 4-H Center (in Shelby Co. near Columbiana)

**Who For:** This is a camp for youth ages 9-13. Activity groups will be divided into age groups (ages 9-11, 12-13). Youth will learn new skills, gain leadership and citizenship experiences, and enjoy making new friends.

**Cost:** The cost will be \$60 per youth and chaperone and covers meals, supplies and activities and lodging. Participants must bring their own towels & sheets.

**WORKSHOPS:** Day I will include “hands on” alternative energy activities, while Day II will be devoted to outdoor recreation. Participants will learn about biofuels, solar cooking, energy conservation, air cars, wind energy and light bulb spiders, and they will participate in wind-powered boat races, canoeing, sportfishing, shooting sports, and swimming. They will interact with experts from the Alabama Cooperative Extension System.

**REGISTRATION:** Register by June 26 to ensure a place for your child! See below for registration form. Write on the form if your child wants to be on the leadership or inspiration committee. Leadership Committee responsibilities: lead 4-H & American pledges; serve snacks; give announcements; present awards. Inspiration Committee responsibilities: give non-denominational blessings at meals; present a ten minute non-denominational inspirational program for vespers.
