Volunteers are invited to bring posters and table-top exhibits showing what their clubs have been up to during the past year.

Poster displays should be on regular sized white or color poster board and may be flat or incorporate 3-dimensional elements (whatever you can attach to the poster board). These will be hung for display. The table-top exhibits should be on tri-panel boards and may include items displayed in front of the board. These will be displayed on tables provided at the forum.

Volunteers will stand with their display during the poster/display session and explain the program or activity depicted. \$50 awards will be given to the best posters and displays! **Presenters must be present to win.**

Awards will be given in the following categories:

- Best visual presentation
- Most innovative program or activity
- Best representation of 4-H ideals/spirit
- Best promotion of 4-H
- Wish I'd Thought of That Award
