**What You Will Learn**

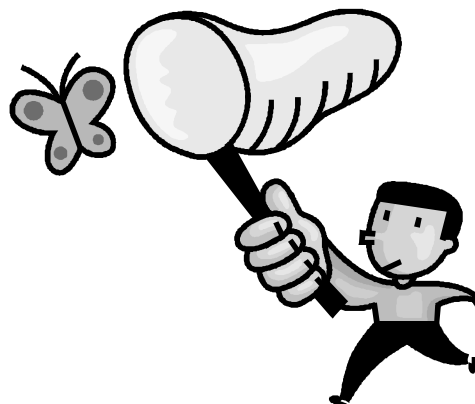
- **Present It With Power!** helps you build new skills.
