Alabama's FY 2006 U&CF Award Subrecipients

City of Andalusia (\$10,816.70)

Federal funds will be used to hire community's first full-time urban forester. This new municipal employee will help manage and maintain the city's urban forest program.

Alabama Urban Forestry Association (\$10,930)

Federal funds will be used to continue organization's transition to administrative self-sufficiency allowing publication of membership newsletter, upgrade web site, and publicity and membership campaign.

Central Alabama Regional Planning & Development Commission (\$9,466.50)

Federal funds will be used to research other communities to develop a model tree ordinance template. This template will then be used by member communities to develop their own customized tree ordinance with staff support from CARPDC.

City of Florence (\$15,000)

Federal funds will be used to contract with qualified company to review city's urban forestry program and produce specifications manual. Funds will also be used to hire intern to research and assist in the revision of city's tree ordinance.

Magnolia Springs Garden Club (\$4,500)

Federal funds will be used to contract with qualified company to assess trees in community park and produce master plan to restore urban trees.

City of Montgomery (\$30,624)

Federal funds will be used to complete tree inventory data collection, purchase and install tree inventory software, purchase three tablet computers, and one GPS unit..
