## National Drug Take Back Day is October 27

**Normal, AL, October 2018**---The Alabama Cooperative Extension System's Urban Affairs and New Nontraditional Programs unit, the Partnership for a Drug-Free Community, WellStone Behavioral Health, the Department of Public Safety at Alabama A&M University, and other partners will participate in the DEA National Prescription Drug Take Back Day on Saturday, October 27 from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. When unused or expired drugs are thrown away incorrectly, medications can end up in the water supply, as part of local landfills, or even in nearby garbage cans where people can easily find them.

This year Madison County area residents and organizations have five drop-off sites for residents to bring unwanted prescription and over-the-counter medication for proper disposal. Unwanted drugs will also be accepted for pets.
