## RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. This show is managed and administered as a partnership between the Alabama Cooperative Extension System (4-H) and the Alabama State Department of Education (FFA).
2. Competition is open to active members of a chartered Alabama 4-H club that has regularly scheduled, planned, experiential educational meetings. To be eligible for competition at events held between August 2008 and July 2009, requiring 4-H membership, the exhibitor must be 9 years old prior to January 1, 2009, i.e., born in 1999 or earlier. 4-H exhibitors who are 19 years old prior to January 1, 2009, (born in 1989) are not eligible to compete.
3. Competition is open to active members of a chartered local chapter of the Alabama FFA Association. High school graduates are not eligible to compete after December 31, 2008.
4. **All entries, to be eligible to show, must list the USDA Premise ID number on the entry form.** A FREE downloadable form is available at [http://agi.alabama.gov/premise-id\\_forms](http://agi.alabama.gov/premise-id_forms).
5. **NO FAXED ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED!!**
6. Market hogs must be owned, eartagged and under the direct care and management of the exhibitor by December 1, 2008. Proof of ownership must be available if requested.
7. All market hogs must be identified with the "Alabama Market Hog Eartag" by **December 10, 2008** and the information must be recorded on the entry form that must be completed for each entry and signed by the exhibitor, parent/guardian and appropriate Extension Agent/FFA Advisor or 4-H Volunteer Club Leader. Signatures certify that the exhibitor, parent/guardian, and agent/advisor/leader will abide by the rules and regulations. Completed entry forms must be mailed to Bob Ebert, 111B Upchurch Hall, Auburn University, AL 36849-5625, no later than **December 15, 2008**. **NO FAXED ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED!!**
8. All market hogs entered **MUST** be source verified, by listing the breeder of the market hog entered on the entry form. Market hogs, with no breeder listed on the entry form, will not be eligible for the 2009 Alabama State 4-H & FFA Market Hog Show, Montgomery.
9. Each exhibitor may enter an unlimited number of market hogs, but can only show a maximum of six (6) market hogs. Only those market hogs eartagged and identified on the entry forms will be weighed and allowed to show.
10. Ownership of all animals entering the Garrett Coliseum Complex remains with the exhibitor. The exhibitor is responsible for feed and care during the show and retains ownership at the conclusion of the show.
11. All market hogs will be individually weighed between 8:30 AM and 11:00 AM, Saturday, January 17, 2009 and screened by the Inspection Committee. There will be no reweighs!
12. Barrows or gilts are eligible to show. Entries weighing less than 200 pounds or not of show quality or condition (injured, unsound or lame) will not be allowed to show in the market hog show. Authority for this rests with the Rules Committee.
13. Market hogs qualifying for the show will be sorted into classes by weight, regardless of breed or gender. Classes will contain no more than 15 animals.
14. Market hogs may begin arriving at the Lewis Barn anytime after 9:00 AM, Friday, January 16, 2009.
15. Exhibitors must show their own market hog in all classes, including Showmanship. A substitute driver will be permitted when an exhibitor has more than one animal in a particular class. The substitute driver must meet Rule #2 or 3, above.
16. The decisions of the judge and rules committee will be final.
17. Complaints or suspected rules violations should be directed to a member of the rules committee before the end of the show.
18. Market hogs **CANNOT** be loaded-out until **AFTER** the selection of the Grand Champion Market Hog.
19. Failure to comply with these rules will result in forfeiture of premium money and/or future show privileges.
20. Premium monies for the show will be determined at the conclusion of the 2009 Alabama State 4-H & FFA Market Hog Show.
21. Age of the exhibitor/competitor will be calculated as of January 1, 2009.

22. A Champion Exhibitor and a Reserve Champion Exhibitor will be selected in each of three Age categories. To be eligible, exhibitors MUST compete in the all of the following components of the 2009 Alabama Market Hog Show:
- Swine Agri-Knowledge Event [A forty (40) Point Exam consisting of questions and identification items designed to test the general knowledge of the exhibitor about the swine industry].
  - Judging Contest (typically 2 classes of Hogs are judged, each class with a maximum of 10 questions asked orally and answered immediately after judging the class)
  - Showmanship
  - The exhibition of one or more Market Hogs [only the two (2) highest placing market hogs per exhibitor can accumulate points for the exhibitor].

23. The three Age Divisions for the Swine Agri-Knowledge Event, Showmanship Classes, the Judging Contest and the Grand Champion Exhibitor Awards are:

Junior	Exhibitors with birth-years of 1995 to 1999 (13 & younger)
Intermediate	Exhibitors with birth-years of 1993 & 1994 (14 & 15)
Senior	Exhibitors with birth-years of 1990, 1991 & 1992 (16 & older)

24. The Swine Agri-Knowledge Event and the Judging Contest is open to any 4-H or FFA member, regardless if they are an exhibitor or not, in the 2009 Alabama State 4-H & FFA Market Hog Show.

25. Points for the Swine Agri-Knowledge Event will be awarded in the following manner:

• Number of Correct Answers	40	39	38	37	36	35	34	33,	ETC
• Points	40	39	38	37	36	35	34	33,	ETC

26. Points for Showmanship Classes and the Judging Contest will be awarded in the following manner:

• Placings	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8	9	10	11	12	ETC
• Points	40	38	36	34	32	30	28	26	24	20	20	20	20

All other participants will receive a maximum of 20 points for Showmanship and Judging.

27. Points for the individual Market Hog classes will be awarded in the following manner:

• Placings	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8	9	10	11	12	ETC
• Points	20	19	18	17	16	15	14	13	12	11	10	10	10

Only the two (2) highest placing market hogs per exhibitor can accumulate points for the exhibitor. Each exhibitor will receive a minimum of 10 points per animal, up to a maximum of two (2) market hogs.

28. Plaques will be awarded to the first place Judging Team (3 individuals from the same county) in each age category.

29. Each exhibitor is expected to be knowledgeable of the Youth PQA Plus (Pork Quality Assurance Plus). The purpose of this educational program is to enhance the educational component and to raise the awareness of "Pork Quality Assurance" as it relates to the production of a wholesome and safe food product, pork. To address the pork quality issues for youth producers and those involved in the showing, the National Pork Board (Pork Check-off) has developed the Youth PQA Plus. This program outlines the 10 GPPs (Good Production Practices) to be used in the production of a safe, wholesome high quality pork product. Some of the questions/answers of the Swine Agri-Knowledge test will come from this material.

Market hogs not matching the description listed on the form will not be eligible to show.

Exhibitors will retain ownership of their market hogs and will be responsible for transporting their animals away from Garrett Coliseum Complex at the conclusion of the show on January 17, 2009.

It is important that an accurate count of market hogs in each county/region be obtained so that the appropriate number of eartags can be sent to each county/region. Tags should be ordered no later than November 3, 2008 to assure delivery by November 7, 2008. Only one shipment of tags will be made to a county/region. The cost of each eartag is \$2.00. To facilitate the handling of money, the purchased tags MUST be paid for at the time the data is sent with the entry forms to Bob Ebert by **December 15, 2008**. Unused tags must be returned to Bob Ebert.
