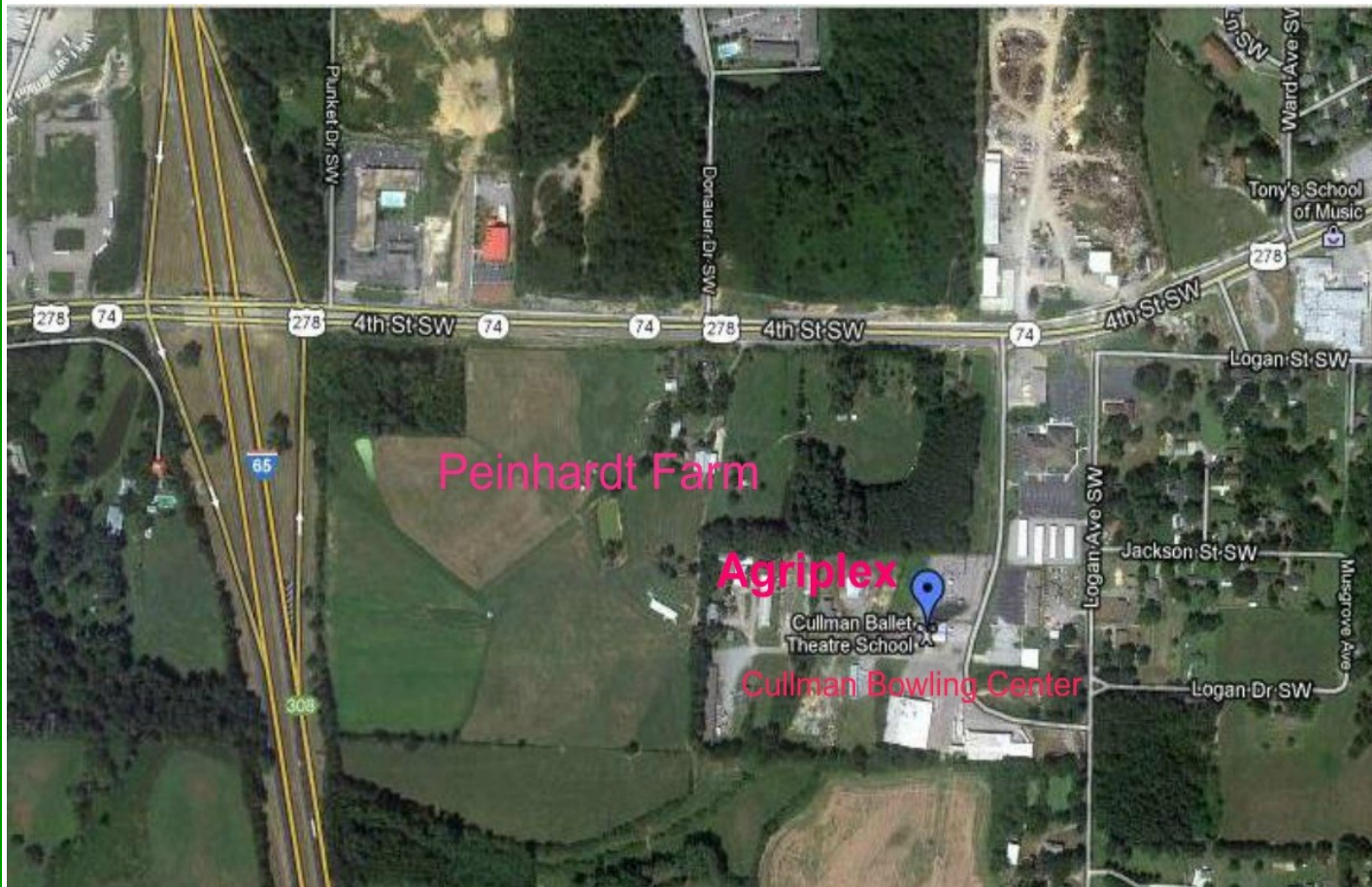

Driving Directions North Alabama Agriplex Heritage Center: 1714 Tally Ho Street SW, Cullman, AL 35055

From I-65:

1. Take EXIT 308, (US-278 E/4th St SW/AL-74 E), toward Cullman/Double Springs.
2. Drive East (toward the city of Cullman) for three-tenths mile.
3. Turn right onto Tally Ho Road
4. Turn right before you reach the Cullman Bowling Center and the Agriplex will be the 2nd building on your right. The Agriplex building has a wooden porch across the front and white siding
