



Finished Barrel (except blue – down spout extender not included)



Here is a finished and installed barrel showing you how to connect to the gutter downspout and plumbing the overflow into an existing drain – you provide the plumbing past the elbow that gets overflow out of the side of the barrel. You can use 3" S&D thin walled drain pipe available at hardware stores or simply clamp the flexible drain pipe onto the elbow and direct wherever you want the overflow to go. The cinder blocks are not included but are a good idea to make it easier and to allow for better flow.



Your tank will look like this except it may or may not have a pallet attached to the bottom as shown here. It will have the metal from and the outlets as described.
