Avoid parking vehicles on dry grass.

Please dispose of cigarettes appropriately.
Never throw cigarettes out your car window!

Secure trailer chains behind vehicles.
Dragging chains makes sparks!

Avoid outdoor cooking, firepits, and campfires.
