



Minimum Requirements for Youth Participants

If youth participants fail to comply with any of the following portions of the program, they will no longer be a member in good standing. Only members in good standing will be Alabama 4-H Chick Chain participants.

- Be enrolled in 4HOnline.
- Attend the mandatory meeting and take the pretest.
- Pay the fee.
- Pick up the chicks.
- Participate in educational meetings (minimum attendance: 50 percent).
- Participate in the home visit.
- Attend the local 4-H Chick Chain Show.
- Participate in other activities offered at the show (photo contest, poster contest, 4-H Avian Bowl, showmanship, etc.).
- Participate in the 4-H Chick Chain Auction.
- Take the posttest.
- Submit a completed 4-H Chick Chain Record Book.
- Complete the program evaluation.
- Participate in the fee refund.

If a 4-H member drops out of the program, it is the responsibility of the county or regional coordinator to report the reason for the noncompliance. That will require the county or regional coordinator to contact the member, record the reason for noncompliance, and record the reason in their program's final report.
