


Educators Going WILD at Landmark Park in July 2019!

Project WILD is an interdisciplinary conservation and environmental education program, emphasizing wildlife through interactive activities. The goal is to help learners develop awareness, knowledge, skills, and commitment that result in informed decisions, responsible behavior, and constructive actions concerning wildlife and the environment.
