AGE The Midwinter Teen Leadership Retreat is for enrolled seniors (4-H ages 14 to 18).

REGISTRATION Registration opens Friday, November 1. A one-time, nonrefundable payment of \$130 per person is due with registration. The last day to register through 4HOnline is Friday, January 10. Registration is limited to the first 120 participants. Online registration instructions are on the website at www.alabama4h.com. Registration includes lodging for two nights, meals, supplies, and a T-shirt.

AGENT EXPENSES 4-H Foundation regional Extension agent expenses will come from his or her allotted travel account.

DRESS CODE Attendees should follow the guidelines of the Alabama 4-H Dress Code. You may want to bring dinner party attire for the banquet Saturday night. Casual or sports clothes are appropriate for the rest of the event. Come prepared for cold weather and rain. Each participant must bring a pair of closed-toe shoes.

CHAPERONES Each county is to send at least one adult from its 4-H county team or a volunteer (age 21 or older) with its county delegation. Volunteer leaders must have been screened and trained and have received letters of acceptance as a county volunteer from the county Extension coordinator or appropriate 4-H Foundation REA.

FORMS Each youth must bring a paper copy of the Alabama 4-H Youth Consent Form or complete the form in 4HOnline.

Young people who drive themselves to the 4-H Center will be required to leave their car keys with Joy Scott after they check into their rooms.
