Notes and Assumptions

- 1 Soil samples cost \$10
- 2 Soil Samples are pulled evert three years
- 3 Soil Samples are pulled on 10 acre grids
- 5 Seed is planted with a no-till grain drill
- 6 Land is sprayed once with 1 QT of 2,4-D Amine
- 7 Land rent is not included but charged to the cow-calf or stocker operation
