NATURAL RESOURCES

- **86,104** youths engaged in natural resources and environmental education.
- **104** youths demonstrated best management practices in forestry and wildlife.
- Youths caught **24** different species of native fish from **41** different public water bodies and **16** private ponds through the Biggest Catch Contest.

CITIZENSHIP & LEADERSHIP

- **25,019** youths engaged in citizenship and leadership activities.
- **3,146** youths participated in 4-H community service projects.



ANIMAL SCIENCES

- **842** youths participated in small animal programs.
- **460** youths participated in Chick Chain and poultry projects.
